On-going Project of Proposer

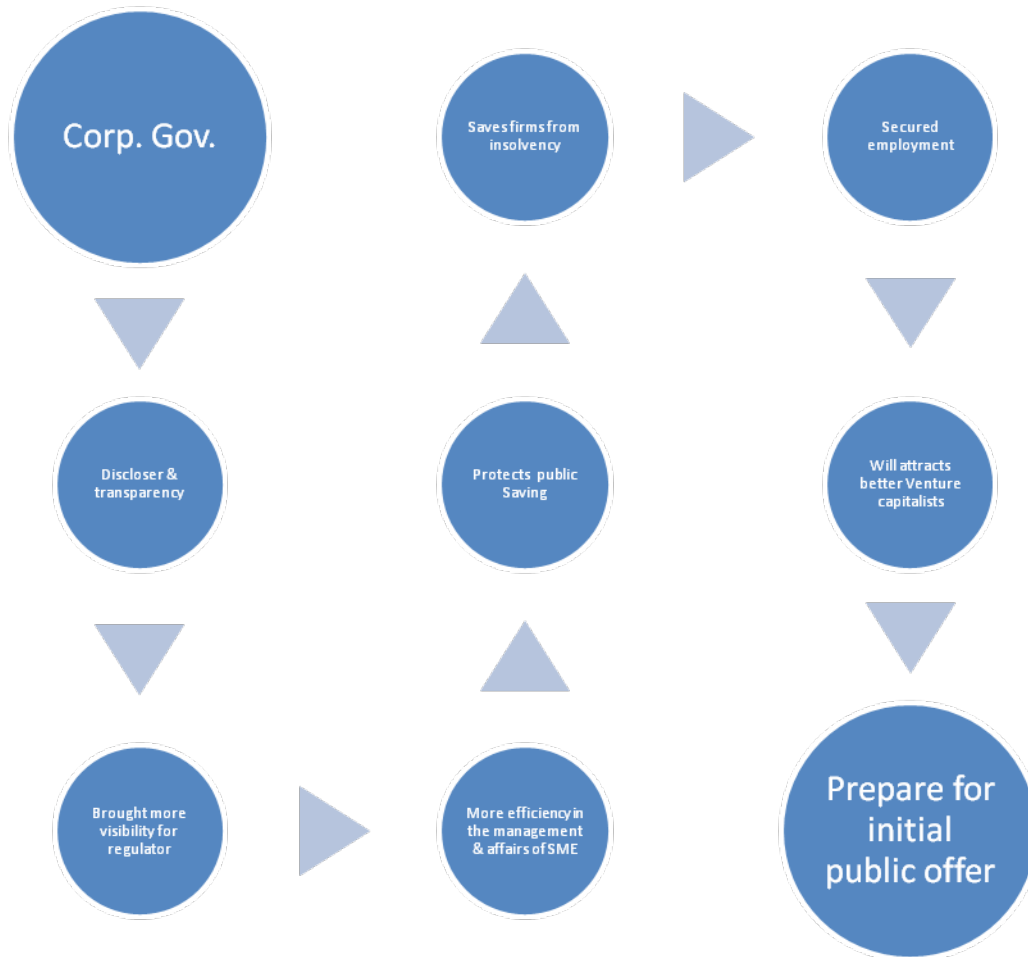
